Larry E. Bieri Sensei, began his study of Aikido in February, 1971 at the Aikido World Headquarters in Tokyo, Japan, the original source of all Aikido styles and the parent organization of the United States Aikido Federation. For the next 16 years he received continuous instruction from a large number of Master Teachers, all direct students of Founder Ueshiba Morihei. Returning in April, 1987, he was made a Shido-in (Certified Instructor) by the U.S.A.F. In 1997, he started Finger Lakes Aikido in Ithaca, New York. Now ranked 7th dan, Shihan, Bieri Sensei also teaches at Cornell University's Cornell Aikido Club and gives seminars by invitation.



While in Japan, Bieri Sensei also practiced a number of "samurai" combative traditions passed down since the days of warfare with bladed weapons. He continues to train in these arts today and this experience influences his approach to Aikido.
